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By signing below, I hereby acknowledge that I have read and accept the following terms conditions and understandings:

I, _____ acknowledge that all services are provided strictly on a volunteer basis, without any remuneration and without liability of any nature on behalf of the Welland and District Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. I acknowledge that all services are provided at my own risk.

I recognize that in handling animals and performing duties as a volunteer, there exists a risk of injury including physical harm caused by animals. I further understand that the behaviour of domestic animals in our shelter may be unpredictable and that domestic animals are capable of spreading disease and/or inflicting injuries and may cause serious personal injury or death, as well as extensive property damage. Knowing the risks of handling domestic animals; nevertheless, I hereby agree to assume those risks and to release, indemnify and hold harmless any persons who might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages. On behalf of myself, my heirs, personal representatives, and executors, I hereby release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless the Welland and District Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, its agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims, causes of action, or demands of any nature or kind, including costs and attorney's fees, based on losses, damages or injuries which may be incurred or sustained by me during my services as a volunteer and all consequences thereof. This includes but is not limited to animal bites, scratches, accidents and other injuries.
